What is the Research Support Fund Program?

The Research Support Fund (RSF) program is funded by the Government of Canada to assist Canadian post-secondary institutions with the costs associated with managing their research enterprise and helping universities and colleges to maintain a world-class research environment. This permanent program provides Canadian universities and colleges with an annual grant to help pay for a portion of their indirect costs of research. How is the Research Support Fund Calculated?

Grants are based on funding that institutions have received from the three federal granting agencies in the three years preceding the grant cycle.
